REGULAR MEETING FEBRUARY 8, 2011 GALWAY TOWN HALL

Supervisor Hargrave called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. The following Town Board Members were present:

A motion was made by Councilman Topper, seconded by Councilman Tillson to approve the minutes of the January 11, 2011 Regular Meeting as submitted.

Communications – Town Clerk stated that Board Members received copies of the following correspondence: Weekly updates from State Comptroller dated 1/10-14; 1/24-28; 1/31-2/4/11; Dog Control Officer's Report for January with Shelter Report for December; Assessor's Report dated 2/8/11; Highway Department Report for January with schedule for February & New Contract with Galway Emergency Medical Services. The following correspondence was also received: Email transmittal of 2011 vehicle id cards from Adirondack Trust Insurance, information forwarded to Highway Superintendent; Monthly notification from Time Warner Cable of possible changes in services/stations along with yearly insurance certificate; Notification from State of NY Department of State advising that Local Law #1 of 2010 was filed with their office on December 29. 2010; Audit of Town Clerk's Books by Supervisor Hargrave, advising that records were found in good order; Notification from NYS Dept of Transportation advising receipt of speed limit reduction request for Alexander Road, study has been initiated; Correspondence from Attorney Horigan advising that Selective Insurance will have him represent Town at Hearing on February 11, 2011 at Town Hall & Notification from Saratoga County Board of Supervisors that cell phones & E-mail addresses can be added to Emergency Notification Services.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: Assessor – Nothing in addition to written report. **Historian** – Phyllis Keeler advised that for a number of years the Historian's office has been working on and compiling a list of surname file. With the increase in genealogy, Brookside has requested that Galway Surname Files be added to their site. Phyllis advised that information will be forwarded to Brookside on or before March 1st.

Councilman Tillson advised that he only had one cemetery left to put on Town web site.

Public Safety – No Report. Property – No Report. Buildings & Grounds – No Report.

Public Affairs – No Report. Highway – For January Highway Department cut brush on Stanton Road; Sanded and plowed 19 days; Pushed back snow banks & Cleared intersections of snow. For February Highway Department seems to be doing more of the same, sanding and plowing as needed. Hope to cut brush if weather allows. County & Town – Supervisor Hargrave advised that Highway Superintendent, Costanzo had his yearly authorization for expenditure of money to be signed by all Board Members. On County level, fighting with State on money for unfunded mandates. The County had 91 people participate in early retirement with over a million dollars in savings. State Comptroller will be in doing an audit of all Town Books in March.

LIAISON REPORTS: Planning Board – Councilman Tillson stated there was no meeting in January. ZBA - No Report. Senior Citizens – No Report. Youth – Councilman Topper stated that Youth Commission is looking at assigning funds to different programs. They are looking into another ski day and also a swim day. Summer Recreation Program has to find alternative housing for their program. School will not be available this summer due to construction. Councilman Topper suggested that they look into the Girl Scout Camp on Alexander Road. Councilman Arnold questioned status of ball field for sign-up purposes. Councilman Topper stated field was ready for use late last spring. Insurance certificate is required, sign-up thru Town Clerk.
