Town Clerk stated Legal Notice was placed in Daily Gazette on April 13, 2018 and posted at Town Hall & Town Website advising the public of a Proposed Local Law to provide for a partial tax exemption for real property taxes for real property owned by persons who rendered military service to the United States during the Cold War (9/2/45 – 12/26/91). Supervisor Lent asked if there were any comments or questions regarding Proposed Local Law, there were none. No written communication was received regarding Proposed Local Law. REGULAR MEETING MAY 8, 2018

GALWAY TOWN HALL

Supervisor Lent called the Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The same Town Board Members were present. Audience was the same with addition of B. Jones; D. Sowle, Youth Commission Char; T. Pudney, Assistant Bookkeeper; N. Gervais & R. Martin.

Pledge to the Flag

A motion was made by Councilman Arnold, seconded by Councilwoman Grant to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2018 Regular Meeting as submitted.

Communications – Town Clerk stated that Board Members received copies of the following correspondence: Tour de Cure resolution is needed for American Diabetes Association to hold a ride, run, walk thru Town on June 10th from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m.; Resolution is needed for Retirement System Standard Work Day & Reporting Resolution for Elected & Appointed Officials, will also be posted for 30 days; Information on ground breaking for new Library along with donation request; Supervisor Lent corresponded with resident concerned with possible foreclosure issue with home, Supervisor Lent gave him contact information; Dog Control Officer's Report for March & April along with Shelter Report for March; Highway Department Report for April with schedule for May; Building Department Report covering 4/10/18-5/8/18; Budget Presentation given to Town of Providence from Galway Emergency Medical Services for Town Board's

review; Mortgage Tax Receipts for Galway covering 4/1/18-4/30/18 in the amount of \$4,334.50; Notification from Amsure Insurance that the Governmental Disclosure Statement had been filed for the 2017 calendar year & Thank you letter from County Clerk, Craig Hayner for the Town Clerk's Office participation in the Freedom Boxes to Celebrate Yellow Ribbon Day.

COMMITTEE/LIAISON/DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS: Highway - Dave Costanzo, Highway Superintendent stated for April they swept roads & intersections; town-wide clean-up after wind storm; cut brush & overhead limbs on Spring Road; hauled gravel; patched; started reconstruction on Dean Lung Road; removed plows from trucks; graded Maple Avenue & Rocky Ridge Road & removed 4-ton weight limit signs. For May they will continue to sweep roads & intersections; continue cutting brush & overhead limbs on Spring Road & Rocky Ridge Road; they finished hauling gravel; pave Dean Lung Road; pave Hermance Road from Route 147 to Greens Corners Road; assist Ballston, Charlton. Greenfield & County; mowing of the Town Hall & Ball Fields have begun. Dave stated that their 20-ton equipment trailer rotted away and he purchased a new one-off state contract. Youth Commission - Donna Sowle, Youth Commission Chair stated spring soccer will begin this coming Saturday and continue thru June 16th; Family Fun Day will be held here at Town Hall on June 16th from 1-4; Learn to swim program will hold two, two-week sessions one beginning the second week in July and second session starting the 4th week of July; Summer Recreation will be held at bus garage this year and Karate will be on lawn for summer.

RESOLUTION #: 20-2018 - Acknowledge receipt of Bookkeeper, Town Clerk & Tax Collector Audit. Councilwoman Grant stated that she and Councilman Arnold audited the bookkeeping records of the Town Bookkeeper, Town Clerk & Tax Collector and found all records to be in order. MOTION CARRIED

Supervisor Lent went into a discussion with Town Board regarding Mobile Food Wagons/Vehicles and if the Board wanted to address this further. Supervisor Lent stated there were two ways to go with this, 1) Make it a permit process that goes thru Code Enforcement Officers Office or 2) Site plan review process with planning board. Board felt permit process was the way to go. Went into discussion, will have Attorney Pozefsky give some suggestions on fees and wording for permit. Town Clerk questioned permit process going thru Code Enforcement Office vs. her office. She stated that vendor permits usually go thru Town Clerk's Office. Supervisor Lent stated that this would be a Local Law change that need to be worded by Attorney on process requirement and fees.

Supervisor Lent went into discussion with Town Board regarding what the Boards feeling were regarding going to one Justice since the resignation of Justice Cappon. Not required by law to have two Justice positions. What is the Boards feeling regarding single Justice vs. two? Supervisor Lent stated that a single Justice can't be expected to do the work of two without increasing the salary. Attorney is looking into how if at all salary for an

elected official can be changed before next budget process. Supervisor Lent stated he believes this would only work out to be a saving of between \$5,000 -\$6,000. Election process will begin soon if Board is looking to keep things as they are. Went into lengthy discussion regarding both options. Court Administration is not a fan of single Justices. Town ultimately makes the decision regarding this. Court Administration also felt they should have input on salary for single Justice, Supervisor advised them that would be the Town Board's call. Supervisor Lent will get more information from Attorney Horigan and bring forward next month; this would only require a Local Law no referendum.

<u>Privilege of the Floor</u> – **Dave Costanzo** requested that since FEMA money was received in the DA4960.3 in the amount of \$31,786, could Town Board put the \$25,000 back into DA5130.4 parts account. Supervisor Lent stated this was not budget funds so the increase in Machinery Account is all that is required.

MOTION CARRIED

Rob Martin, Travel Soccer Club - Rob advised that their club is affiliated with Eastern NY Soccer Club. They have recently put out grant funds for field maintenance, field upkeep & equipment. He talked to Youth Chair and asked it Town would be interested in them applying for a grant to address seed/fertilizer. The cost would be \$6,000 which the Eastern NY Soccer Club would pay \$3,000. Their club would them pay \$1,500 and the Town \$1,500. Discussed who would put this down, or further insurance requirements would need to be met. Highway Superintendent, Costanzo stated that Highway could put down seed and fertilizer. Supervisor Lent stated that there was money set aside that could cover renting of a machine to help with this process. Rob stated that they may want to look at applying for a grant to purchase storage shed to be used by everyone at field in future. Town Board & Supervisor were ok with Rob applying for grant. Town Clerk suggested doing a resolution authorizing them to apply for grant since it was Town fields and the Town would also be matching some of the funding. Supervisor Lent stated the Town Board would do resolution if grant was approved. Supervisor Lent suggested that Rob come back when actual dollar amounts are known for resolution. Rob stated they may want to look at fencing as another grant option down the line. Review period is only a week to ten days for processing. Rob asked that when they look at vendor fees please consider that a lot of the vendors donate a portion of what they make back to the school.

Donna Sowle advised that Family Fun Day on June 16th, 2018 will require volunteers to help. Fred usually does the dunking booth but has to work this year, so any help the Town Board could give would be greatly appreciated.

On a motion of Councilman Arnold, seconded by Councilman Wilday the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
