REGULAR MEETING OCTOBER 11, 2011 GALWAY TOWN HALL

Supervisor Hargrave called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. The following Town Board Members were present:

OTHERS PRESENT: C. Ciembroniewicz, Building Inspector; D. Wescott, Deputy Town Clerk; L. Sanders; T. Killeen, Assessor; P. Keeler, Historian; M. Cuff-Perez; & M. DeFoe, Town Clerk. Attorney Pozefsky arrived at 8:25 p.m.

### Pledge to the Flag

A motion was made by Councilman Topper, seconded by Councilman Weed to approve the minutes of the September 20, 2011 Regular Meeting as submitted.

Communications – Town Clerk stated that Board Members received copies of the following correspondence: Assessor's Report dated 10/11/11; Highway Department Report for September with schedule for October; Weekly updates from State Comptroller dated 9/19-25; 9/26-10/2 & 10/3-10/9/11; Galway Emergency Medical Services Budget Development for 2012; Informational packet from General Code on eCode; Letter from resident requesting tax exemption for Disabled Residents; Packet on implementing exemption for low-income disability & Complaint letters from Herb & Mary Lynn Kopper regarding handling of Sheets/Ercole matter. The following correspondence was also received: Time Warner Cable possible changes in programming & channel services & Letter from County Treasurer advising that county sales tax may exceed 2010 by 2%.

<u>Privilege of the Floor</u> – Lo Ann Sanders requested a copy of the letters from Herb & Mary Lynn Kopper.

of accident on Route 29; tractor trailer went thru guardrails and into water by Dick Weber's. Property – Councilman Weed advised that he and Councilman Arnold are working on inventory. Public Affairs – Councilman Arnold wanted to let everyone know that there may be people scoping out homes for potential robberies; cars have been seen outside homes for no apparent reason; be aware and let police know if you think something looks suspicious. Historian – Phyllis Keeler advised that she attended the County Historian's meeting and was advised that the topic for the 2012 Fair will be to do and exhibit on the war of 1812. Phyllis has been in contact with a representative from the Kesselring site regarding the cemetery on site; he is researching information and will get back to Phyllis with his findings. Went over how information is acquired and Historian's

duties. Assessor – Nothing in addition to written report. Supervisor Hargrave requested that Tracy explain to Town Board how Low Income – Disability Exemption works. Tracy stated this would be similar to the Aged Exemption-sliding scale or Veteran's Exemption. Supervisor Hargrave questioned if this could be done by Resolution or if it required a Local Law? Assessor was not sure what requirements were for implementation of this Exemption. Supervisor Hargrave will check with County tomorrow. Highway - For September the Highway Department Fine graded Graves Road; Paved Graves Road & Parkis Mills Road; Paved with County; Finished clean-up storm damage; Sealed with Charlton & Mowed ball fields & R.O.W.'s. For October they will Pave with Greenfield; Finish Graves Road & Parkis Mills Road; Start screening sand; mow ball fields & R.O.W.'s & work with FEMA on storm damage reimbursement. Dave stated that he is trying to get some figures together on truck for Town Board that he discussed with them at workshop meeting. Councilman Topper stated that he would be ready to begin work on pavilion beams next week. Superintendent, Costanzo stated that he would have area set up in old highway garage for Councilman Topper to use for drilling holes into beams. Buildings & Grounds - Councilman Topper will reapply for Dockstader grant in same amount; will include in grant concrete floor/electric setup/generator to run power. Councilman Topper will donate his time and engineering ability after his term expires. He will see project thru to completion. Town Board was in agreement to include other items in grant request for pavilion. Mary Cuff-Perez questioned if grant was just for materials and if there would be tax money required for this project? Councilman Topper explained how grant worked and advised that there would be no tax burden for residents due to project. County & Town - Supervisor Hargrave stated on both Town/County level working on budget.

LIAISON REPORTS: Planning Board — Councilman Tillson stated that George Stanislowski received a 3-lot classification for subdivision on Mechanic Street. Due to issues with obtaining FEMA trailer due to recent storms Ms. Kenyon requested that Planning Board proceed at a slower pace on the Gamula subdivision on Jersey Hill Road. Board will review application further in November. Art Carpenter presented the final maps on the Weaver subdivision on Route 29. ZBA — Councilman Topper attended Zoning Board Meeting and advised that conceptual approval pending plot plan submission was given to Peter Guidarelli for and area variance on Nassel Drive in Lake District; Planning Board approval will then be required for lot line adjustment. Senior Citizens — No Report. Youth — Councilman Topper stated that youth budget will remain the same. Code Enforcement — Chet stated that status of permits for 2011 will be forwarded to Assessors Office this week for his updating purposes. Will be working with Joe McGrath from NYS regarding reconstruction of apartments on Route 29 after recent fire.

Councilman Topper made a motion, seconded by Councilman Tillson to approve the General Abstract of Vouchers (A) dated 09/20/11 thru 10/05/11 for a total of \$62,794.79.

Supervisor Hargrave stated that the Town Clerk wanted to review information on Thursday evening hours for her office. Town Clerk advised that she met with Councilman Weed; Councilman Arnold; Justice Thomas; Court Clerk Sarnowicz & Deputy Town Clerk Wescott regarding how to handle Town Clerk hours during DA night. Court hours have changed from 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. for Village & 6:00 p.m. for Town Court. These new overlapping hours created confusion for residents trying to do Town Business with the Town Clerk's Office at the same time Court related activity was going on. Due to this change the Town Clerk was considering changing her hours on DA night only to close at 5:00 p.m. After discussion regarding advertising for one night out of the month to close at 5:00 p.m. and the other Thursday evenings to remain at 6:00 p.m. it was determined that it would cause more confusion than necessary. Wording would not work for tax bills or posting of hours on sign board. Town Clerk felt people really wouldn't pay attention to what Thursday night of the month it was. Town Clerk determined that it would be best to close on Thursday evenings at 5:00 p.m. If a couple needs to obtain a marriage license and they can't get into the office when it's open, she will make arrangements to come in at a different time for them. Hours will change in January.

Supervisor Hargrave stated that Town Board Minutes can't be advertised or put on web site until after they have been approved by Town Board. They are not official copies until after approval.

The meeting was adjourned to Executive Session at 8:25 p.m. to discuss proposed litigation. Chet and Attorney Pozefsky were asked to attend.
