
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General Requirements for Driveway Construction/Alteration


- 1. The construction shall be in accordance with the requirements listed herein on plan "STANDARD DRIVEWAY DITCH CROSSING" and all special requirements shown on or attached to the "PERMIT".
- 2. The applicant shall furnish all materials and bear all costs of construction within the Town highway Right of Way and all work done and materials used shall meet the requirements of the Town of Galway Highway Department.
- 3. No alteration or addition shall be made to any driveway within the Right of Way of a Town highway without first securing a new permit. This includes blacktopping driveways.
- 4. The angle of the driveway with respect to the highway pavement edge shall be not less than sixty (60) degrees, or greater than one-hundred-twenty (120) degrees.
- 5. No driveway shall be permitted within fifty (50) feet of an intersection.
- 6. No new driveway will be permitted at a location where the lack of sight distance in either direction along the highway is a hazard.
- 7. Driveways shall be a minimum of twenty (20) feet wide at the highway interface. Driveways shall be a maximum of forty (40) feet wide throughout the road right of way. Double or special use driveways may be wider if deemed appropriate by the Highway Superintendent.
- 8. Pipe to be twelve (12) inch minimum diameter. Pipe diameter to be determined by the Highway Superintendent.
- 9. Drain piping will be made of corrugated metal or A.D.S. pipe. A.D.S. pipe must have a minimum of one (1) foot of cover.
- 10. Pipe shall be placed so the inside flow line of pipe is at bottom of ditch and sloped true to ditch grade, maintaining free and unobstructed flow.
- 11. Roadside shoulder slope must not be altered.
- 12. Design will be such that driveway drainage will flow into the ditch and not on the highway.
- 13. Application for a commercial entrance shall include a fully dimensioned plan of the proposed driveway showing drainage.
- 14. All changes on driveway approaches and culverts due to elevation changes as a result of reconstruction or maintenance of Town highways by the Town will be performed at the Towns expense.
- 15. Special circumstances may require a blacktop apron.
- 16. Applicant has the responsibility for insuring that buried cable will not be damaged during the work. (Call 1-800-962-7962 for cable location).

Highway shoulder slope must not be altered.

Any rise in driveway grade shall occur on back slope of ditch line so that drainage from driveway will flow into the ditch and not onto the highway.
