RESOLVED that the Galway Town Board approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS a public hearing was held by the Galway Town Board on January 12, 2010 for the purpose of considering the formation of a Special Ambulance District; and

NOW, it is resolved that the following findings are hereby made and adopted pursuant to Section 209-e of the Town Law:

- a) the notice of hearing for the public hearing referenced above was published and posted as required by law, and is otherwise sufficient;
- b) all the property and property owners within the proposed district are benefited by the creation of the district;
- c) all the property and property owners in the Town of Galway benefited by the creation of the district are included within the limits of the proposed district;
- d) the establishment of such district is in the public interest; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that the establishment of the special ambulance district be and the same is hereby approved subject to a referendum as provided in Town Law Section 94; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that the referendum as provided in Town Law Section 94 as to the creation of the Special ambulance District shall include a proposition that the maximum amount to be raised by taxes in the Special Ambulance District shall be the sum of One Hundred Eighty Eight Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty Five Dollars; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that such referendum be held not less than sixty (60) days nor more than seventy five (75) days following the filing of this resolution with the Town Clerk and that such referendum be held in accordance with the provisions of the Town Law relating to special elections; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that only those individuals who own real property AND are domiciled within the Town of Galway shall be eligible to vote in such special election pursuant to the requirements of Town law Section 209-e (3).
